Devotional: Our Confident Hope-Part 2

Christian Devotion about having confident hope in God's promises

Let us seize and hold tightly the confession of our hope without wavering, for He who promised is reliable and trustworthy and faithful [to His word]. - <u>Hebrews 10:23</u> (AMP)

We need to stand on God's Word and confess His promises over our circumstances—no matter how impossible it looks to us. It is vital that we hold on with all we have to our confession of hope. Don't ever give in to the temptation to give up because it just seems all too hard.
